Animal Week - Learn about exotic animals with a visit from Mr. Drew. We will learn about tracking animals, a petting zoo and so much more.

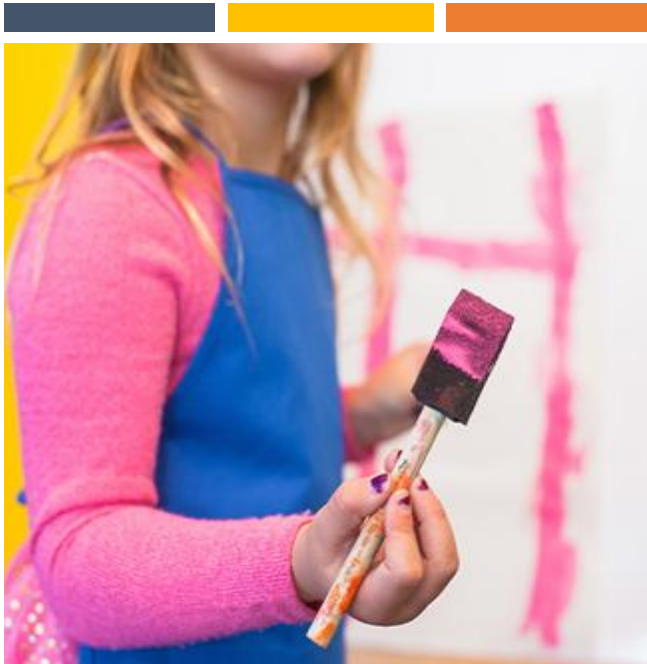
Things That Ooze - Make and create fun exciting projects. From slime to play dough.
